Support conditions: accommodation, catering and travel.

Athletes:

1) *Accommodation*

The organizing committee plans to cover 2 nights (maximum) per athlete whose place of origin exceeds 200km.

For athletes whose place of origin is less than 200km, the organizing committee will only cover 1 night.

All athletes will be in a TWIN room (shared with another athlete).

The hotel for the 2024 edition of the Meeting International de Sotteville-lès-Rouen will be as follows:

Negotiated rates:

- *Single: 115€/person/night (breakfast included)*
- *Twin: 130€/pers./night (breakfast included)*

2) *Catering*

All meals planned for the athletes in the established catering slots will be covered by the organizing committee.

Any supplements outside the established menu will be the responsibility of the athlete.

All products consumed by athletes in the “Bar” area and via the « room service » during their stay will be at their expense.

3) *Travelling expenses*

The organizing committee plans to reimburse athletes' travel expenses up to a maximum of €300.

For all train or plane journeys, only tickets marked “second class” or “economy” will be reimbursed. Otherwise, a study will be carried out so that reimbursement is made in the amount of a “second class” or “economy” ticket.

For those who will travel by car or light vehicle, the organizing committee plans to reimburse the travel costs of these athletes up to €150/athlete or €300/car in the case of carpooling.

Coaches:

0) *Foreword*

The organizing committee agreed to say that only the coach will be recognized as a support person eligible for the following support conditions.

1) *Accommodation*

The organizing committee plans to cover 2 nights for coaches whose place of origin exceeds 200km.

For coaches whose place of origin is less than 200km, the organizing committee will not cover hotel accommodation.

All coaches will be in a TWIN room (shared with another coach).

2) *Catering*

All meals planned for coaches in the established catering slots will be covered by the organizing committee.

Any supplements outside the established menu will be the responsibility of the coach.

All products consumed by coaches in the “Bar” area during their stay will be at their expense.

3) *Travelling expenses*

The organizing committee provides for the reimbursement of travel expenses for coaches whose place of origin exceeds 200km up to a maximum of €200.

For coaches whose place of origin is less than 200km, the organizing committee will reimburse travel costs up to €150 maximum.

For all train or plane journeys, only tickets marked “second class” or “economy” will be reimbursed. Otherwise, a study will be carried out so that reimbursement is made in the amount of a “second class” or “economy” ticket.

4) *Payment proofs*

No refunds can be made without proof.

Rules relating to the transport of athletes and coaches

0) Foreword

A large majority of transport will be done by a team of volunteer drivers in minibus (9 seats).

Out of respect for them, so that we can send them as soon as possible the information concerning the different shuttles which will be allocated to them and in view of the risk to which they are exposed, we ask you to please respect the recommendations below.

1) Travel information

All travel information for athletes and coaches will be sent to René AUGUIN (auguin@wanadoo.fr).

Managers and/or athletes are asked to send outgoing and RETURN travel information, 8 days before the date of the event, on Wednesday June 26, 2024.

2) Transport of athletes between the place of arrival on the territory and the place of accommodation

a) List of train stations and airports accessible by our drivers:

Airports:

- Paris Roissy, Charles De Gaulle, (CDG)
- Paris Orly (ORY)
- Paris Beauvais (BVA)

Train station:

- Rouen Rive Droite

b) Time slots to respect

⇒ Arrivals:

It is asked, as possible, to prioritize arrivals at the airport and train station between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m.

⇒ Departures:

Favor airport departures between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.

No preferred time slot for Rouen Rive Droite train station.
